

# Instructions for your visit as of 29. June 2021

We look forward to welcoming you to an event of the Bayerische Staatsoper. Please observe the following instructions so you can enjoy your visit nice and relaxed, safe and secure. Contact us any time if you have any questions.

- The most important first – **look forward to the time with us!**

- **Admission to each event at Nationaltheater is 120 minutes before the start of the performance.** You can access the Nationaltheater via the entrance to the Freunde-Foyer (Alfons-Goppel-Straße) or via the main entrance. Please see your ticket for your entrance. Currently it is not possible to enter the Nationaltheater via the underground garage. Please arrange enough time for the admission.  
**Admission to each event at Prinzregententheater and Cuvilliés-Theater is 60 minutes before the start of the performance.** The admission to Prinzregententheater is via the main entrance, to Cuvilliés-Theater as well.



- During the admission and in the building please always maintain **sufficient distance** from other persons (**at least 1.5 meters, but 2 meters are better**).

- Please note that as the purchaser of the tickets you are obliged to be able to name those attending the event at all times. Please also pass on these visitor instructions accordingly.

- The visit of a performance is as of 29. June only possible for **visitors with a negative COVID-test, for fully Vaccinated visitors**, or for persons who can prove that they have **fully recovered after a COVID-infection**.

When entering the Bayerische Staatsoper, please always remember to bring your ID card and one of the following documents in a printed or digital version:

- **Current, negative test result** (PCR-test carried out max. 24 hours before the start of the event or an **antigen rapid test** carried out max. 24 hours ago by a medically trained staff) with a personalized certificate. Please note that **no self-tests** are accepted.
- School pass (pupils in Bavaria) with a registered self-testing, which was carried out at the school under supervision max. 24 hours before the start of the performance and certified accordingly by the supervising teacher.
- **Vaccination certificate** for proof of complete vaccination protection (starting 14 days after the final vaccination)
- In case of a survived COVID-19 infection: proof of positive PCR-test result, which is at least 28 days old and not older than six months.

- There are a number of testing centers around the National Theater and the Prinzregententheater where you can obtain a rapid antigen test prior to your visit to the theater. [Here](#) you can find a list of different options.

- Our **theater catering has reopened** and appears in new splendor: In the groundfloor, our restaurant LUDWIG ZWEI welcomes you in new splendour and with a special offer. Please note that the consumption of food and drinks is only allowed at one table. **Please reserve a table in advance via our theatre catering.** We have set up more bar tables throughout the house for you. **Please spread out over all bars.** Open are the restaurant LUDWIG ZWEI in the groundfloor, the RHEINGOLD in the stalls on the right, the champagne bar in the stalls on the left, the bar on the 1st floor on the right and the so-called „Aquarium“ on the 3rd floor.

In the Prinzregententheater, the „Prinzpal“ theatre restaurant is open for two hours before the performance begins and during the interval. Please reserve your seat in advance via [www.theaterrestaurant-prinzpal.de](http://www.theaterrestaurant-prinzpal.de). Unfortunately, it is not possible to cater in the Gartensaal. Weather permitting, an outdoor bar will be open in the garden from one hour before the performance and during the interval. No reservation is necessary for this and you can reach it via the Gartensaal.

The gastronomy in the Cuvilliés Theatre is closed.



- **Please only visit us if you are healthy.** If you feel symptoms or your immune system is weakened by a previous condition, we would ask you with a heavy heart to please stay at home – otherwise we very much look forward to seeing you! If you have had contact with a person with COVID-19 in the last two weeks or if you yourself have been tested positive for the virus, you may not attend either. Please use our ticket exchange ([kartenboerse.staatsoper.de](http://kartenboerse.staatsoper.de)) if you cannot use your ticket for the reasons named above.



- **Please wear a mask, also during the performance.** Adults are required to wear a **FFP2 mask**. Children aged 6 to 15 need a medical mouth-nose-covering. Children below the age of 6 are exempt. In exceptional cases certified by a doctor, visitors are exempt from the mask requirement. If possible, please move „back-to-back“ past each other in the rows. We also ask you not to fan in order to minimise the spread of aerosols.

- **Please sit on your assigned seat.** You'll find the seat number on your ticket. We would urgently ask you not to move to one of the free seats. You can find an exemplary seating plan [here](#) (there might be daily variances due to production-related causes).



- **Be a hygiene role model!** Needless to say you do of course know all the current hygiene rules, hygiene etiquette or similar advice providers. Thank you for acting as a role model; others will follow your example. And our front of house team will open the doors for you, so you get to your seat without touching any handles.

- **Enjoy your visit!** We're delighted that you are here with us again. Let's spend a relaxed and enriching time together!
